## **SCRIPTURE**

This course provides an introduction to Sacred Scripture and its interpretation. Key doctrines covered are inspiration; canonicity; inerrancy; and the relation of Scripture, the Magisterium and Sacred Tradition.

## **CREED I**

This course focuses on the first part of the Creed. Subjects include revelation, faith, the Trinity, creation, Jesus Christ, and the paschal mystery.

## **CREED II**

An exploration of the truths articulated in the second half of the Creed; in particular the Holy Spirit, the Church, and the four last things.

## **SACRAMENTS**

This course addresses the seven sacraments. Significant time will be given to an understanding of the liturgy and an introduction to the sacraments.

## **CHRISTIAN LIFE**

This course addresses key principles of Catholic moral teaching.

## **PRAYER**

This course offers an introduction to prayer and an overview of the foundations of the spiritual life, with a focus on ongoing conversion of heart.

## **TEACHING CHASTITY**

This course is designed to give parents, catechists and youth ministers the tools and resources necessary to communicate the good news of chastity to teens.

## **VATICAN II: A GIFT TO THE CHURCH**

An examination of the main documents of the Second Vatican Council. Close attention will be paid to the impact of the Council on the faith and life of the people in the pew!

## **APOLOGETICS**

This course serves as an introduction to Catholic Apologetics, or defense of the Faith. Current and recent events will also be discussed as they relate to apologetics.

## **METHODOLOGY & CLASS MANAGEMENT**

This course will look at the components of methodology as well as student learning styles, instructional techniques, and classroom management.
